

## 1992-1993 Henry G. Burke Grants

JASNA established the Henry G. Burke Grants in 1990 to support research and creative projects that help bring Jane Austen's name before the public. The Grants were named in honor of one of JASNA's founders.

The 1992-1993 Grants have been awarded as follows: to Paula Schwartz and Neil Moyer, to assist them in the writing of a complete, full-length, two-act musical drama based upon *Sense and Sensibility*; to the Julia Rogers Library, Goucher College, for the creation and distribution of a descriptive guide to the Burke Collection of Jane Austen materials in their possession; and to Joan Austen-Leigh to assist her in the writing and publication of a novel entitled, *Letters from Highbury*.
